MASCO BOKURE

DESCRIPTION

MASCO BOKURE is a state of the art curing compound that will revolutionize the concrete construction industry. This membrane forming cure will not discolor concrete surfaces, nor does it need to be removed prior to applying further surface coatings. MASCO BOKURE is a premium cure, hardener, and dustproofer for new or aged concrete surfaces.

USES

- Concrete decks, floors, sidewalks, and driveways.
- Architectural walls, columns, and beams.
- Ideal for parking garages, warehouses, schools, food processing plants, hospitals, etc.
- Interior and exterior surfaces.

FEATURES AND BENEFITS

- An entirely unique cure, hardener and dustproofer.
- Produces a moisture resistant membrane to control hydration. Results in a concrete surface with increased abrasion and impact resistance.
- When applied per instructions product is compatible with further surface coatings, cementitious mortars and adhesives, and paints.
- No need to remove prior to covering cured concrete surface with tile, carpet, or wood.
- Produces a bright and clean concrete surface that will not yellow.
- Does not contain any waxes, silicones, or paraffins.
- Does not contain any flammable or combustible solvents.
- Ready-to-use formulation.
- No special cleaning required. Just rinse equipment with water after use.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Stir MASCO BOKURE slowly and thoroughly using slow speed mixing equipment before each use. Do not aerate with high speed mixers.

APPLICATION TECHNIQUES

New Concrete

Horizontal Floors & Slabs: Apply after surface water sheen has disappeared from the concrete surface. As soon as concrete surface is hard enough to walk on, apply MASCO BOKURE with a low pressure sprayer in a uniform and continuous manner. See prescribed coverage rate table below. **Avoid over application.** Do not allow material to puddle on concrete surface. Do not apply if rain is expected within 48 hours, white crystals may develop.

Vertical Concrete: After stripping vertical formwork, immediately apply MASCO BOKURE with a sprayer. Hold spray tip approximately 2 feet from the surface and apply in a uniform and continuous manner at 400–500 sq. ft./gal. Do not apply when temperature is below 40°F (4°C). Do not apply MASCO BOKURE over free standing water.

SUBSEQUENT SURFACE COATINGS

Allow new concrete to cure for 28 days prior to applying paint or coatings. These application procedures do not supercede further surface coatings manufacturers' instructions.

COVERAGE

Broom finish	300-400
Hard troweled	500-600
Vertical surface	400-500
Age concrete	200-300

Note: Coverage varies with porosity of concrete. Product should never be puddled. Overapplication may cause a white residue.

CAUTIONS

Do not apply to frozen surfaces or when temperature is below 40°F (4°C). Do not apply if rain is expected within 48 hours, white crystals may develop. Protect material from freezing. If white crystals begin to develop, this is an indication that too much material has been applied. Rinse over applied areas with water and squeegee off remaining puddles. If material is sprayed on glass or other finished surfaces, quickly wipe-up with warm soapy water. Not for use on exposed aggregate, masonry, or colored concrete. Check with coating manufacturer for their guidelines. MASCO BOKURE instructions do not

supersede the paint or coatings manufacturers preparation or application instructions.

PACKAGING: 5 gallon, and 55 gallon DOT approved containers.

FIRST AID
